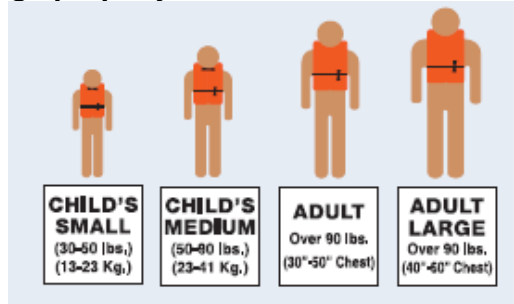




## PRE-BOAT LAUNCHING CHECKLIST

Basic Boating Safety Equipment: (all safety items below For SALE at ticket booth)

- ✓ **Do you have enough properly sized Life Jackets for everyone onboard the vessel?**



- ✓ **Every child 11 years old and younger must wear a Life Jacket at all times when the vessel is underway. Do you have enough child sized Life Jackets?**
- ✓ **Do you have a throwable (Type-IV) floatation device, such as a floating cushion?**
- ✓ **Do you have at least one Type B-1 Fire Extinguisher rated for marine use?**
- ✓ **Do you have a Visual Distress Signal device onboard, such as an orange flag?**
- ✓ **Do you have a Sound Signaling Device onboard, such as a horn or whistle?**

Boat Operational Check:

- **Is your boat plug in?** (Boat plugs For Sale).
- **Do you have enough FUEL in the boat?** (No fuel available on Lake Elsinore)

Prepare for Launching:

- **Load all personal items onboard the vessel (coolers, picnic supplies, etc...).**
- **Remember to remove all boat straps and covers.**

Boat Launching:

- **WARNING - Boat Ramp may be SLIPPERY!**
- **Back the trailer down the ramp slowly until the boat's stern is afloat and then ease the boat off the trailer. Avoid placing rear tires in the water.**
- **Don't back into the water too deep!**
- **Please do not tie up to the dock, as this causes traffic congestion at the ramp.**

Boating Regulations:

- **Read & understand the Lake Use Regulations by obtaining a City brochure.**
- **The Daily Lake Use Pass contains a condensed version of the Lake Regulations.**
- **Direction of Travel on the Lake is Counter-clockwise.**

The Sheriff's Lake Patrol is charged with the responsibility of boating safety on Lake Elsinore. The Sheriffs enforce all laws and regulations of the State of California. The City and Sheriffs reserve the right to refuse launching of any vessel for safety reasons.
