RULES & REGULATIONS

L.E.M.C Chapter(s) 8.40 & 6.04

Operating Hours:

- 🐾 Open Monday thru Friday from dawn to 10:30 a.m.
- 🐾 Days and hours of operation are subject to change without notice by the City for maintenance and special events.
- 🐾 The designated "Dog Play Area" is confined to the fenced enclosure of this lower baseball field.

Warning(s):

- 🐾 Enter at your own risk. Visitors entering the fenced "Dog (off leash) Play Area" during operating hours are at risk of being bitten, knocked down or tripped by unleashed dogs.
- 🐾 Dog owners are responsible and liable for the behavior of their dog at all times, including injury to persons and damage to the Park's landscape and infrastructure.
- 🐾 Adults accompanied by children under the age of five (5) years are discouraged from entering.
- 🐾 Strollers, carriages, bicycles and children's toys are prohibited.
- 🐾 Children under the age of fifteen (15) years must be accompanied by an adult.
- 🐾 Smoking, alcoholic beverages, food and dog treats are prohibited.

Dog Requirements:

- 🐾 Dogs are permitted to be "off leash" within this fenced area only.
- 🐾 Dogs must be leashed when entering or leaving this area.
- 🐾 Dogs must have a current license and vaccinations.
- 🐾 Dogs must wear a collar, with the dog license tag attached. Choke, prong, spiked or shock collars are prohibited.
- 🐾 Dogs that are sick or in heat are prohibited.
- 🐾 Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior, such as biting or growling, are prohibited and shall immediately vacate the area.
- 🐾 Dogs that bark excessively and become a public nuisance shall vacate the area.
- 🐾 Puppies under four (4) months of age are prohibited.
- 🐾 Digging by dogs is prohibited.

Owner Requirements:

- 🐾 Owners must remain with dogs inside the fenced area at all times.
- 🐾 Owners must immediately remove and properly dispose of their dog's droppings.
- 🐾 Owners must possess a leash at all times.
- 🐾 Owners are limited to a maximum of two (2) dogs at one time in this area.
- 🐾 Owners must retain proper identification in their possession.

Enforcement:

- 🐾 Report violations to the City Parks & Recreation Department.
