Crime Free Business is modeled after the success of the Crime Free Multi-Housing Program (C.F.M.H.), which was established in July of 1992 by the Mesa Police Department in Arizona. The C.F.M.H. program is a progressive, crime prevention program designed to reduce illegal activity, drugs, and gangs in multi-housing properties.

Crime Free Business is designed to reduce crime in and around service and retail businesses and provide a safe work environment for employers, employees and customers. The program gives retail and service establishments proven strategies/standards to reduce the opportunity of crime. The program and training is offered at **"no-cost"** to all participants.

There are two phases to becoming certified as a Crime Free Business:

- Phase I : Program Introduction
- Phase II: On-site security inspection/evaluation

What are the benefits of being certified as a Crime Free Business:

- Improved safety and security to business owners/managers, employees and customers
- Increased customer volume - participation in the program is "good for business"
- Program specifically tailored to the security and safety needs of your business
- Updated and ongoing information on local crime and crime prevention strategies by working with your local police department
- Using the Crime-Free Business logo on advertisements, announcements etc.
- Attend quarterly meetings with continued education on crime prevention
