



PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Lake Elsinore Engineering Department, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the City's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located between Lake Street and Black Powder Road (downstream of Barnard Street). The flood hazard revisions are being proposed as part of Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) Case No. 19-09-2208R for a proposed project along Temescal Wash. The City of Lake Elsinore is proposing to update the floodplain and floodway limits as part of the Temescal Canyon Bridge Realignment Project. Once the project has been completed, a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) request should be submitted that will, in part, revise the following flood hazards along Temescal Wash.

1. The floodway will be revised from station 105986 (cross section BT) to station 110422 (Lake Street) along Temescal Wash.
2. Base Flood Elevations (BFEs) will both increase and decrease along Temescal Wash.
3. The Special Flood Hazard Area will both increase and decrease along Temescal Wash.
