



NOTICE INVITING BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids will be received by the City of Lake Elsinore for the work generally described as:

ANNUAL ASPHALT MAINTENANCE PROGRAM AMP20 – Project No. Z10002

Bids will be received via Planet Bids only by the hour of 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 20, 2020.

Each bid shall be made on the proposal form furnished in the Specifications and submitted via Planet Bids clearly marked with the title of the work. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the bid is received in proper time on the day and time stated above. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time maybe rejected.

Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.1, any Contractor bidding, or subcontractor to be listed on a bid proposal subject to Public Contract Code section 4104, shall not be qualified to bid after March 1, 2015, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No Contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract or perform work on any contract for public work, after April 1, 2015, without proof of current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 to perform public works.

SCOPE OF WORK is for the Annual Asphalt Maintenance Program which consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor and incidentals for maintenance, repair, and construction of asphalt pavement located within Lake Elsinore city limits. The amount of work to be assigned is determined by the annual budget approved by the City Council. **The contract is for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.**

All bids must be made in accordance with and as directed in the Specifications, and all bidders shall comply with Federal, State and local laws applicable thereto. **All bids must be received by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 20, 2020**, proposals shall be submitted via PlanetBids only. Bids must be clearly marked **ANNUAL ASPHALT MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**.

The City Staff reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in a bid and to award the Contract as may best serve the interests of the City. All proposals are binding for a period of thirty (30) days after they are opened any may be retained by the City for examination and comparison.
