Greetings from Lake Elsinore's Community Services Department! We are thrilled you want to become an integral member of our summer team. This packet is intended to provide you with detailed information about the LIT application processes. Please carefully read all application information and be sure to make note of important dates and requirements.

Interviews are tentatively scheduled to occur virtually on **May 23, 2023**.

Leader in Training Program

The primary goal of Lake Elsinore's Leaders in Training Program (LIT) is to create and foster leadership through hands-on experience at our day camps and Youth Room. While anyone between the ages of 13-16 may apply, we would like to remind all applicants that space is limited and acceptance into the program will be based on answers to supplemental questions, availability, and interviews, if necessary. Any teen with a strong desire to work with children is encouraged to apply. Successful LITs are generally enthusiastic, dedicated, and devoted to providing our camp participants with a memorable experience.

What is a Leader in Training?

Leaders in Training are invaluable members of our winter day camp team as they provide support to our recreation leaders. Volunteers are trained in supervision, safety, problem-solving, and leading camp activities. They will receive on-the-job training and job skills that are not available through other mediums and will assist staff with leading camp activities. At the end of each week, volunteers will receive evaluations of their participation and suggestions for areas of improvement. Teens who want to cultivate their leadership skills are encouraged to volunteer all for multiple weeks of Summer Camp.

By the end of the camp, our goal is for volunteers to feel more confident in themselves, their leadership style, and be able to successfully prepare for the workforce.

Requirements & Expectations

Volunteers that are admitted to the program will be expected to meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least 13 years old by **June 12, 2023** (day of orientation/training).
- Volunteer for a minimum of 2 weeks.
- Responsible for own transportation to and from program sites.

By signing the following contract, I, _____ agree that I understand and accept the requirements and responsibilities that accompany being a Leader-in-Training and agree to the following rules and expectations.

- I will follow and enforce all camp rules as outlined by camp staff.
- I will maintain a positive attitude.
- I will use appropriate language at all times.
- I will be camp appropriate even when campers are not present (i.e. during training, on my breaks, etc.)
- Bullying of campers or fellow L.I.T.s will not be tolerated and may result in my termination.
- I will strive to support and encourage campers and fellow L.I.T.s.
- I understand that camp exists for the enjoyment of the campers and not for me.
- I will make campers my priority.
- I understand that campers look up to me and so I will serve as a positive role model at all times.
- I realize that recreation leaders rely on me to help camp run smoothly and so I will follow through on my tasks and responsibilities to the best of my ability.
- I will ask for help when I need it or when I'm not sure what to do. I know that staff is there to support me.
- I will only use my cell phone during scheduled breaks.
- I will wear my L.I.T. shirt whenever I am at camp.

In a worst case scenario, failure to abide by these rules and guidelines may result in my immediate termination from the program. Lesser circumstances may result in being put on a behavioral contract and probationary status. This means that you must abide by the terms and conditions of the behavioral contract in order to continue to serve as an L.I.T.
