



## I-15/SR-74 (CENTRAL AVENUE) INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



### **1. What are the main differences between the alternatives?**

Besides the construction of new northbound [NB] on-and off-hook ramps, widening of the NB off-ramp, the southbound [SB] ramps and segments of local roads, the main difference between Alternatives is that Alternative 3 adds a NB loop off-ramp that provides direct connectivity between I-15 NB and SR-74 WB.

### **2. When is construction scheduled to begin?**

Construction activities are estimated to begin in 2026.

### **3. Will traffic on the freeway be affected during construction?**

Traffic on the freeway is not anticipated to be affected. However, shoulder closures or reductions would be required at certain locations to install portable concrete barriers. The concrete barriers would shield the work areas for construction of new ramps and segments of auxiliary lanes, widening of existing ramps, drainage improvements, installation of guard railing, installation of ramp metering equipment and signals, and installation of various roadside or overhead freeway signs.

### **4. Will there be detour routes needed during construction?**

Short-term detours may be required during construction at the I-15/SR-74 interchange ramps.

### **5. Will construction affect public transit bus services?**

Existing bus stops are located within the Project limits. The only bus stop affected during construction would be along eastbound Central Avenue at Cambern Avenue. However, this location would remain open and accessible throughout the duration of construction.

### **6. Will my property be affected?**

The Project requires right-of-way from some of the commercial properties located on the east side of I-15, adjacent to the interchange, and from properties located on the east side of Cambern Avenue at the intersection with Central Avenue. Access to all properties would be maintained at all times during construction.

### **7. How is the Project being funded?**

Local, State, and Federal funding sources including grant opportunities are being considered for construction funding of the Project.
